Are you a tax-exempt entity like a local government, Tribal government, school, library, non-profit hospital, non-profit organization, or house of worship?

Did you complete a renewable energy project in 2023?

Then you could be eligible for money from the IRS!

Under Direct Pay, tax-exempt entities can receive a cash payment from the IRS for installing eligible sustainable energy projects such as



Solar panels



Geothermal



Wind turbines



Ground-source heat pump



Electric vehicles



Electric vehicle charging stations

YOU MAY NEED TO ACT BEFORE MAY 15TH!

- If you're a government entity filing a tax form for the first time, you get an automatic paperless extension until Nov 15.
- If you're an entity that's filed a tax form previously (like a 990 or 990T), you will need to submit Form 8868 to request an extension by your tax deadline (May 15th for many) so you have time to pre-register.
